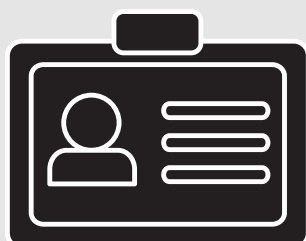


HOW TO SPOT A CENSUS ENUMERATOR

Know how to identify a census enumerator if they come knocking!

CENSUS-ISSUED ID

All census enumerators should immediately present their Bureau-issued identification. This ID should include their name, photograph, a Department of Commerce watermark, and an expiration date.

CHECK OUT THE "SWAG"

Census enumerators will have an official bag and Census Bureau-issued electronic device, such as a laptop or smartphone, bearing the Census Bureau logo.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Census enumerators (also known as census takers) and field representatives will conduct their work between the hours of **9 AM-9 PM**, local time. Census takers may also be present at community events.

INFORMATION THEY WILL NOT COLLECT

Census enumerators **WILL NOT** collect:

- your Social Security number
- money or donations
- anything on behalf of a political party
- your bank or credit card account numbers
- your mother's maiden name
