Mayor's Message

I am so glad that the 90th Anniversary events were such a great success! I want to thank all members of the North Brentwood Citizens Association for their dedication and hard work. The president, Ms. Tiffany Jones, did an excellent job to lead our members in the right direction. I want to express my gratitude to Kenneth Felder, who came up with the idea to make a float years ago, but helped us all he could to make the float and significant to our town 90th Anniversary parade.

The meetings for the Mayor and Council will not resume until September. We have accomplished a lot, including the approved FY 2015 budget, upcoming closing of purchase of property located at 4516 41st Avenue, shredding, cleaning of the streets and swales and survival of water problems. The water problems are still being reviewed and we are in close contact with a high official of the Department of Public Works.

We have also straightened out some street lighting billing issues and will be upgrading lights in the town. This process will take a while. Please be patient.

I have been swamped and inundated with problems and resolutions that I will be taking some time off in July and August. I would like for our citizens to contact any councilperson concerning problems. They are the first source that you should use and they have been well trained to contact the appropriate personnel or to get some answers and resolutions to the problems. Give them the full detail about your problem, your name address, and contact numbers, so that they can get back to you with a reply.

The park on Allison Street is not complete but should be soon. There has been impervious asphalt paved in the park which will aid in handicap access. New handicap tables are placed on the park, including a new water fountain. There is a single colorful shade that will be placed over top the play equipment to keep our children safe from the sun.

Remember the Rental License process has begun. It became effective on July 1, 2014. Renters have been sent notices and should already have paid for their annual rental permit fee (\$50.00 yearly). If you have not been contacted and you have a rental facility in North Brentwood, contact the code enforcement office, Freddie Glass.

We, the mayor and council, are looking for ways to keep our streets safer and slowing traffic down. Remember our children are out playing and you do not need to have a bad day when you accidentally hit one. Not only children, but anyone. Slow Down....!

Come out and be a part of National Night Out / Back to School Night on August 5th. More information is available in the newsletter. Have a fun and safe summer. See you at the meetings!

Budget Notes and Assumptions

- Business Tangible Property Rate set at \$1.20 and Utility Tangible Property Rate set at \$1.50 per \$100.

- Purchase of property located at 4516 41st Avenue.

- Balance of DNR Grant in the amount of \$14,476 to be expended in FY15.

- Total Payroll Tax (FICA) represents employer liability only. Employee portion of an equal amount to be paid by employee per IRS Regulations.

- Effective July 1st, 2014, Rental Permits will be billable at \$50 each, per ordinance.

- FY14 Encumbrance earmarked as \$10,000 partial payment towards Solar Panel removal and installation; and \$10,000 towards new roof for Town Hall.

Attn: Handicap Residents with handicap sign in front of their residence

If you are a disabled resident in the Town of North Brentwood, the town has provided you with the courtesy of handicap parking in front of your residence. Unfortunately due to strict Maryland State Laws and to keep a conflict from arising on your residential street it is very important that you contact MVA at 1-800-950-1682 to officially reserve a parking space near your home. Anyone who has State issued handicap tags or a handicap placard in the front window of the vehicle is allowed to park in front of a handicap sign.

You should request an application for personal residential permit for a reserved parking space from the MVA. You may obtain the form.

By calling customer service center 1-410-768-7000

By calling or mailing a request to the MVA investigation and security services division.

In person from an MVA branch office.

By calling the MVA fax on demand system (410) 424-3050

By downloading a copy from the MVA's website on the internet. (www.mva.maryland.gov)

When the application is completed and returned, the MVA investigation and Security Services (ISS) division will review the application to see whether any of the following conditions exist that may disqualify your request.

Your doctor certifies your disability is not permanent.

Your residence is located in a private community or is located on a private roadway.

Off-street parking is already available (examples garage, driveway, parking pad).

No member of your household has a Maryland registered vehicle.

Your residence is on a street where parking is prohibited.

There are no fees charged to reserve the parking space, for additional information and questions please contact the customer service center at 1-410-768-7000.

The Town of North Brentwood needs a current copy of your disability documentation that is kept on file for the Town records, this documentation should be kept current and a copy should be given to the Town every time it is renewed.
