## REAL PROPERTY TAX INCREASE FOR 2013-3014 BUDGET

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDANED**, BY THE Council of the Town of North Brentwood that the tax rate for fiscal year 2014 for all real and personal property which is subject to taxation by the Town of North Brentwood shall be as follows:

Residential Real Property	\$0.4400 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation;
Commercial Real Property	\$0.5857 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation;
Utility Real Property	\$1.50 per \$100 of assessed valuation and
Business Personal Property	\$1.20 per \$100.00 of assessed valuation.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the annual budget for fiscal year 2014 in the amount of \$308,846 of anticipated revenues and expenditures, as set forth on the budget attached to this Ordinance and made a part hereof by reference, is adopted.






