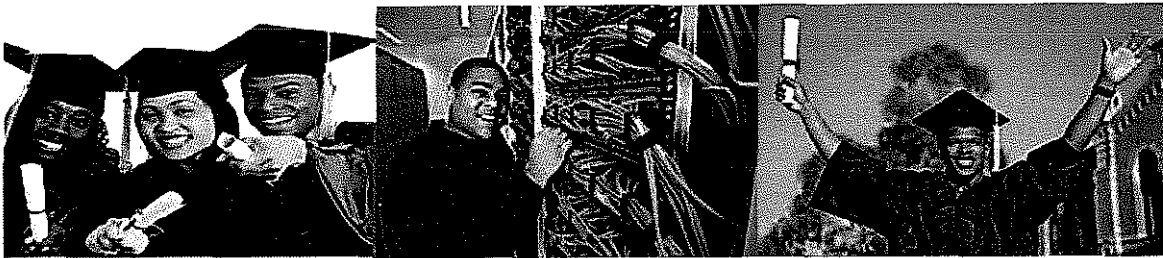

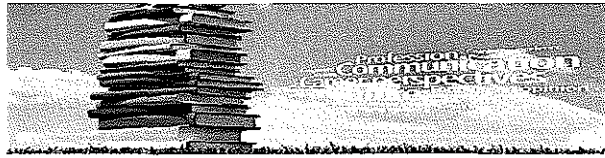

Application guidelines and forms are available at the local Mayor's Office. The deadline for submission is April 14, 2017 at 5pm. The winning TOWN OF NORTH BRENTWOOD student will be presented with the scholarship at the Maryland Black Mayors Annual Honors Gala on May 5, 2017.

DESCRIPTION

The MBM Inc. Scholarship is our general scholarship awarded annually. The scholarship does not require a specific major of study and is open to full-time students (based on educational institution's definition at time of enrollment). Each application will be reviewed and judged by a member-municipal committee. This scholarship committee will select winning applicant.

AMOUNT

VARIES (\$500 MINIMUM)

CRITERIA

1. Completed application form
2. Must live in MBM member-Municipality (see below)
3. Must be enrolled in Maryland college/university/technical/trade school (2015/2016)
4. Must have GPA: 2.30 (C+)
5. Personal essay from the student (500 words or less).
Essay Topic: "Pick an Experience from your Own Life and Explain How it Has Influenced Your Development"
6. Two (2) letters of recommendation. One recommendation should come from a community or public service leader (i.e. church leader, community leader, volunteer organization). Email addresses will be requested of each recommender for electronic submission of the letter. Hard copy letters will not be accepted
7. Must be **U.S.** citizen
8. One (1) page resume listing extracurricular activities, honors, employment, community service and special skills
9. A recent photograph suitable for publication; i.e., a cap and gown picture, or other professional quality and professionally dressed photograph
