Municipal Election May 2, 2016

Two Council Seats Open

The Town of North Brentwood will elect two (2) Council members, May 2, 2016. The polls open from 1pm to 7pm at the North Brentwood Municipal Center, 4009 Wallace Road, North Brentwood, Maryland at the side entrance of the building.

Voter Registration

If you are registered to vote with the Prince George's County Board of Elections at a North Brentwood address, then you are registered to vote in the town's elections. All new voter registrations and changes of address must have been received by the Prince George's Board of Elections by April 1, 2016. Voter registration forms are available online.

Absentee Ballots

Voters who will be absent from the Town election and who cannot personally appear to vote at the polls on election day because of illness or physical disability may apply to vote by Absentee Ballot. Applications or letter stating the need for an absentee ballot (including the reason why you will not be able to appear personally) must be received at the town office no later than April 22, c.o.b. 1pm. Your application or letter will be reviewed and you will be sent an absentee ballot. The ballot must be sealed in a sealed envelope, mailed and received in the town office no later than Thursday, April 28, c.o.b. 1pm.

Qualifications of Candidates Prospective Candidates

Candidates for a council seat must have resided in the town for at least 30 days immediately preceding the election, must be at least 25 years of age and a registered voter of the town.

The Candidates for two (2)council seats are as follows: **Markel Day, Catherine Sutton, and Charles Wiley.**

Finding Your Historical and Genealogical Roots

The caption refers to a series workshops sponsored by Coun- cil Member Deni Taveras in partnership with the Prince George's African American Museum & Cultural Center at North Brentwood. Inc. The workshops focus on *Online Sources for Genealogical Research, DNA in Genealogical Re- search, and Slave Records*.

The sessions will provide the attendees with a step-by-step "how to guide" to tracing African-American Lineage. They will show participants how to identify sources, records, and other tools needed to organize and manage research materi- als. Activities will include surfing genealogical websites on the internet, preparing for a research trip, developing a fam- ily tree, conducting oral interviews, understanding DNA test- ing, planning family reunions, and unlocking the mysteries of genealogy.
