A Resolution supporting the Town of North Brentwood's application for a Community Legacy grant for a storm drain improvement at 41st Avenue, and generally relating to the Community Legacy Program and grant funding.

WHEREAS, the Charter of the Town of North Brentwood, Section 602(18) empowers the Town to pass ordinances to allow the acceptance of gifts and grants of Federal or State funds from the Federal or State governments or any agency thereof, and to expend the same for any lawful public purpose; and


WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of Community Programs of the Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (the "Department") on August 25, 2017 has written a letter to the Mayor stating that the Department requires that a local government resolution or a letter of support from an authorized designee expressing approval or disapproval of an applicable project under the Community Legacy Program be provided to the Department.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Town of North Brentwood to hereby approve and support the Community Legacy Program Application identification number SRP-CL-2018-NBrentwood-00305 for the Town of North Brentwood for a project known as the "Storm Drain Improvement at 41st Avenue" to improve storm drainage at 41st Avenue including re-grading the street terminus and adjoining curbs, and the design and installation of a rain garden, and interpretive signage in the requested amount of \$45,000.00, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall be effective immediately.
