During this challenging time, as we all deal with impacts of COVID-19, the Town of North Brentwood offices will remain closed until April 30th. The Mayor and Council are in continuous contact with Federal, State, County and Local officials daily receiving updates about the virus.

Our town offices are being cleaned by our public works official and he is working daily during this time to ensure that the town infrastructure is maintained as he continues with his daily duties. We do not anticipate disruption of services for our citizens, including trash, bulk and recycling pickup. We do urge all citizens to call the town office and submit their contact name and telephone number so we can reach you to keep you informed. Hopefully, we already have your contact information for our phone tree, if not please call and leave your name and the best phone number to reach you at (301)699-9699 so that we can add you.

Prince George's Public Schools will be closed until April 24th.

All MNCPPC buildings are closed until April 30th, please avoid touching surfaces on playgrounds or other outdoor areas. MNCPPC discourages gathering in parks and remind patrons it is illegal to gather in groups of 10 or more.

- Stay calm and at home as much as possible. If you must go out, maintain a 6-foot distance from others
- Wash your hands often with soap and warm water for at least 20 seconds on both sides and between your fingers.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol if soap and water are not available.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.
- Avoid people who are ill.
- Disinfect high-contact surfaces, such as doorknobs and tables.
- Make sure that you protect yourself when using gas nozzles, ATM's and touching other areas.

We anticipate Town meetings will be held virtually on Mondays April 6 and April 20. We will inform you concerning of the conference call access numbers by means of community channel, Facebook, website, town office door and through the town's phone tree calls. We welcome all of our citizens to participation.

I am glad to see that most of our citizens are adhering to the rules. Social distancing is a must! We must continue to adhere to state emergency rules. If we obey, we can reduce the number of cases. Thank you for your continued support doing this difficult time. Stay healthy and safe.
