**Voter Registration Deadline:** April 7, 2020

**Offices:** All registered voters of the Town will vote for two council persons to represent the town.

**Candidate Filing Deadline:** Candidates petitions must be filed by Tuesday, April 7, 2020, cob, 5:30 pm.

**Petitions must be presented / delivered to one of the election judges.**

### ELECTION INFORMATION

The Town of North Brentwood election for two (2) council seats will be held on Monday, May 4, 2020. Polls open from 1pm – 7pm at the North Brentwood Municipal Center, 4009 Wallace Road, North Brentwood, Maryland. Please use the side entrance of the building.

### **Voter registration**

If you are registered to vote with the Prince George’s County Board of Elections at a North Brentwood address, then you are registered to vote in the town’s elections. All new voter registrations and changes of address must be received by the Prince George’s Board of elections by April 6, 2020. Voter registrations forms are available online [http://www.elections.state.md.us/voter\\_registration/application.html](http://www.elections.state.md.us/voter_registration/application.html) (There is an underscore between voter and registration.)

### **Absentee Ballots**

Voters who wish to vote by absentee ballot may do so by requesting an absentee ballot by application at the Town office. Your application will be reviewed, and you will be sent an absentee ballot. Your absentee ballot must be returned in a sealed envelope, mailed and received in the town office no later than April 27, 2020, cob 1pm.

### **Qualification of Candidates (wishing to run for seat)**

Candidates for immediately preceding the election, Candidates for the Council Seats must have resided in the town for at least 1 year immediately preceding the election and be a qualified voter of the Town.

### **Petitions for Candidates**

In order for a candidate’s name to be placed on the ballot, he or she must submit a petition for councilmember candidacy to one of the election judges. The petition for the councilmember seat requires 10 signatures of registered town voters. It is advisable to get more than 10. The petitions can be obtained at the town’s office or from town’s website: [www.northbrentwood.com](http://www.northbrentwood.com).

Your petition must be delivered to one of the election judges no later than Tuesday, April 7, 2020, cob, 5:30pm. Petitions must be submitted to Attn: Board of Supervisor of elections, Town of North Brentwood, 4009 Wallace Road, North Brentwood, Maryland 20722. The election judge will certify each petition.
